From the Vice President,

There have been a few trail changes. For now, trail 47A & 47B will be closed this year.

We spent a lot of time & money renting an excavator with a brush cutting head.

We used this to trim the brush back along our trails this year and plan to do more next year.

Last year we started painting the tops of our stakes with fluorescent orange paint to make them more visible in the fields during the day.

The Chautauqua Lake Snowmobile Club gets .08 cents back per gallon when you purchase fuel for your snowmobile. The money goes towards improving our trails. All you need to put your receipt in the envelope and fill out the information on the front. The gas stations along the trails have envelopes inside or you can place them in the envelope at the clubhouse.

We need more volunteers to help with preseason trail work. The trails don't appear by themselves. We have over 240 miles of trails to maintain. We have weekend work parties, the information is posted on our Facebook and Webpage. We need help with cutting brush, clearing trails, signing, and building bridges. Hope to see you on the trails
